

Grogan's Point Residents' Association Security Program

The GPRA Security Program was established in 1996. Since 2003, Montgomery County Precinct 3 Constables have provided extra patrols for Grogan's Point and is an important neighborhood asset.

WHAT THE PROGRAM PROVIDES

- Dedicated off-duty Constables in marked patrol vehicles (officer hours are scheduled based on resident participation)

COST

- Cost is \$300 per calendar year, starting Jan 1 thru December 31, primarily used for patrols

- GPRA Security Committee coordinates patrol hours with the Constable Office's assigned liaison who is currently Detective Adam Acosta.
